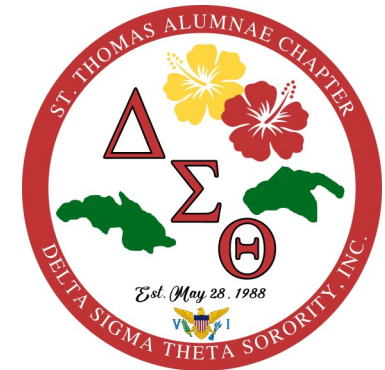

Application Requirements

Applicant must be a senior in good standing at a public, parochial, or private high school on St. Thomas/St. John and should have the following:

- 1) Table of contents.
- 2) An official copy of your high school transcript evidencing a numerical grade of an 83% GPA or 3.0 on a 4.0 grading scale or better reflecting first and second marking period.
- 3) A copy of a letter of acceptance from an institution of higher learning.
- 4) An autobiography, to include your hobbies and interests, extra-curricular activities and your future endeavors. Include headshot photo,
- 5) TWO essays: one page per essay, expounding on two topics; the mandatory essay and one essay from the optional topics listed.
- 6) TWO letters of recommendation: one from a Teacher/Counselor & one from a Public Service Organization attesting to your public service involvement.
- 7) All items must be submitted electronically as one pdf file. Applications not in this format will not be considered.
- 8) School counselor's form with signature, verifying review of final submission

Essay Questions

You must write a well-developed essay on the Mandatory Essay Topic and then select one Optional Topic.

Essays should not exceed one page.

Mandatory Topic:
